Melanoma in the eye

Skin cancer can spread to the **orbit and the eye**, says a recent study in the *Survey of Ophthalmology*. "Patients diagnosed with skin melanoma should seek an eye exam to see if it has metastasized to the orbit or eye," says Paul T. Finger, MD., who co-authored the study. "The best treatment is prevention, so use sunblock cream for your skin and don't forget sunglasses for your eyes," he adds. www.nyee.edu
